



A Brief Account Of Annual General Meeting 2010-11

Annual General Meeting (AGM), 2010-11 of WBCS (Executive) Officers' Association was held at *Rabindra Sadan* on 5 March 2011. In spite of heavy engagement of officers in the preparatory work of the conduct of forthcoming assembly election 340 members attended it. Prior to AGM a Delegates' Session was organized on 26 March at *Abanindra Sabhagriha*. 75 delegates joined the session.

In his report Shri Pradip Jana, General Secretary of the Association, explained the context in which agitational programme was deferred against the State Pay Commission Report (Part-II) after the submission of memorandum statewide. "The Hon'ble Finance Minister assured us that those (*demands of the Association on career advancement*) would be considered when the Government would take decisions about SPC's recommendations", he said. Shri Jana expressed his satisfaction as the Government's disagreement with the observations of the SPC was communicated to him in writing.

While dwelling upon organizational matters the General Secretary expressed his concern over the increase in a section of members not taking part in the Association's activities. He referred to the posting of Shri Niloy Ghosh as Special Secretary in charge and splitting of pay band 4 into 4A and 4B as two important gains.

Aikat, Sri Sourav Chaki and Sri Santanu Mukherjee shared their views on different issues, which ranged from conduct of election to involving more senior officers in organizational activities.

A presidium consisting of Sarbashri Niloy Ghosh, Pradip Jana, Liakat Ali and Nilanjan Shandilya conducted the proceedings.

DEMANDS

Following demands were adopted in the AGM:

1. To implement the order according to the coordinating role to BDO, SDO and DM without further delay;
2. Demands already placed to the Govt. re-iterated:
 - a) To award two additional increments at the entry level and also in the next two pre-revised higher scales (as awarded to the IAS);
 - b) To create 60 posts in scale No. 20 and increase the number of posts to 35 in scale No.21 (both pre-revised) for the WBCS (Exe);
 - c) To allow special allowances of Rs.500 in scale No.19 (pre-revised);
3. To introduce a Risk Allowance / Insurance for the WBCS (Exe) officers posted in the affected districts including hill areas;
4. To extend the last date of submission of enrolment in the West Bengal Health Scheme, 2008;
5. To open more posts of District Magistrate and also to open the post of Secretary for the WBCS (Exe) officers;
6. To link the status of Deputy Secretary with the pre-revised scale No. 18;
7. To publish the Civil list without further delay.
